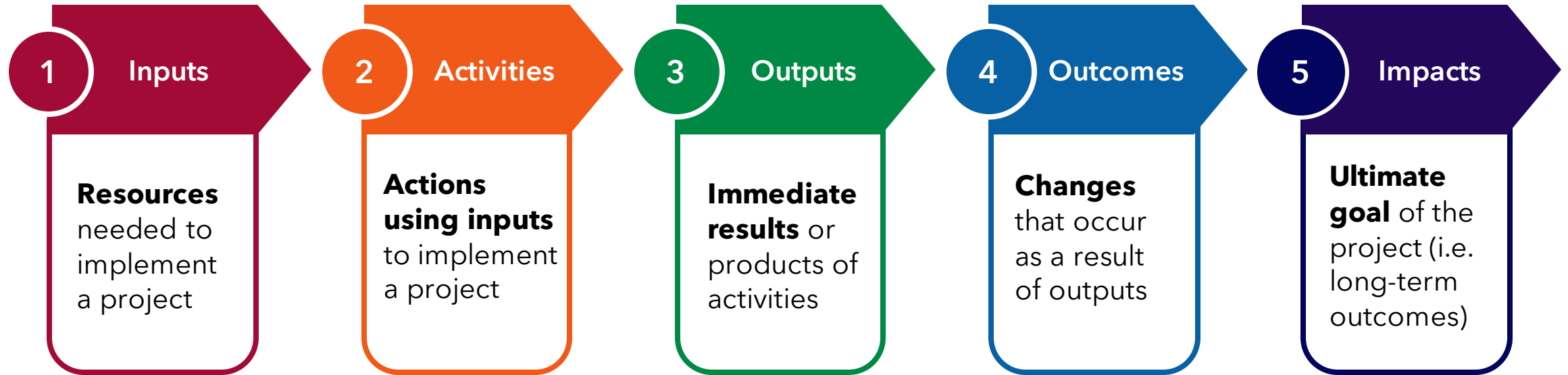

Tracking Measures

Metrics that help you track the **implementation** of your project. These may include your **inputs, activities**, or similar **milestones**.

Output Measures

Output Measures

Outcome Measures

Niece's reported happiness level (1-10 scale) upon opening gift
Niece's enjoyment of gift (1-10 scale) 12 months after opening gift

Survey Section 2: Project Timeframe

Select the appropriate **quarter**:

- When do you expect to **complete** this project?
- Estimate when **25%, 50%, 75%, & 100%** of SFRF \$ will be **obligated**
- Estimate when **25%, 50%, 75%, & 100%** of SFRF \$ will be **expended**

Survey Section 3 : Project Impacts

Think about the **overall, long-term impact** you anticipate your project to have and **when this impact is expected**:

- Describe the **expected overall impact** of the project.
- **When** do you expect the project **impact to be realized**?

Survey Section 4: Geographic Scope

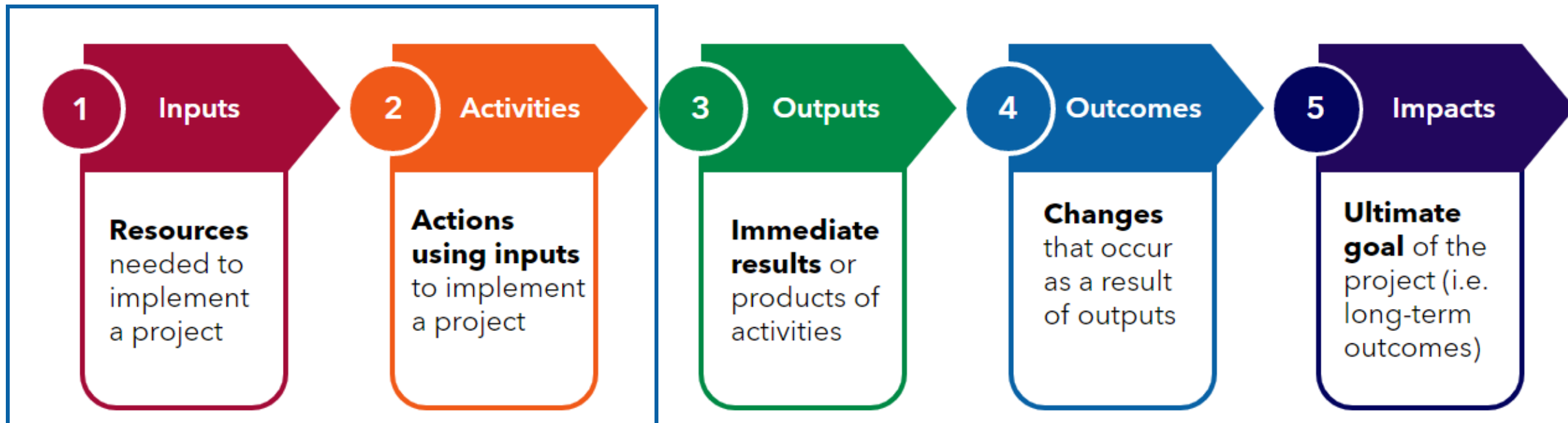
Think about whether your project affects **only specific counties** or **all of North Carolina**.

- What **area** of NC does your project impact?

Survey Section 5: Project Inputs and Activities

Focus on major **inputs** and **activities** for your project.

- List **inputs** for your project
- List **activities** for your project



Survey Section 6: Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)

For this section think about what **KPIs** you use to gauge project **progress** and/or **success**.

- **Name** of measure
- **Type** of Measure
- Brief **description**
- **Unit** of measurement
- Measuring **Strategy/ Data Source**
- Measure **start date**
- Measure **end date**
- **Frequency** of reporting to NCPRO (quarterly, semi-annually, annually).
- Does this KPI measure **equity**?
- (If KPI measures equity) How is KPI data **disaggregated**? (Race, income, geography)
