
Onslow County Summary

Resilience Score: 37.03

In 2022, Onslow County achieved a Resilience Score of 37.03, which is average as compared to the North Carolina State average.

Business Community Health: 5.49

This component examines the strength and diversity of the local business community, including factors such as the number of businesses, employment levels, and industry diversity. Onslow County's performance on this dimension is fairly weak when compared to other North Carolina counties, ranking 86th in the state.

County Government Fiscal Strength: 45.02

This component looks at the financial health of local governments, including their ability to generate revenue, manage debt, and maintain adequate reserves to weather economic downturns. Onslow County's performance on this dimension is average when compared to other North Carolina counties, ranking 46th in the state.


Household Characteristics: 62.06
