Q1: Can you explain the purpose of Attachment C in NCPRO's Memoranda of Understanding with state agencies and Non-State Entity Award Agreements with subrecipients, and specify when its use is required?

A1: Attachment C sets forth the State Fiscal Recovery Fund (SFRF) award terms and conditions as established by the U.S. Department of the Treasury. These provisions govern the use of federal funds by the State of North Carolina, its agencies, and any subrecipients. The terms and conditions of the federal award must be incorporated into all agreements with subrecipients to maintain compliance with program requirements. By doing so, subrecipients are also bound to follow these federal requirements.
